INSPECTING YOUR ROOF AFTER THE WINTER

If you notice any issues, it's important to have them repaired or replaced as soon as possible to prevent leaks and further damage.
- **Flashing:** Inspect flashing around roof penetrations for signs of damage or separation. If you notice issues, have them repaired ASAP to prevent leaks.
 - Gutters: Inspect your gutters for any blockages or damage. Make sure they are securely attached to your roof and that the water is flowing freely through them.
- Attic: Inspect your attic for any signs of water damage or leaks. Look for any dampness, mold, or water stains on the walls or ceiling.
- **Chimney:** Inspect your chimney for any signs of damage or wear. Look for any cracks, gaps, or missing bricks.
- Skylights: Inspect your skylights for any signs of damage or wear. Look for any cracks or gaps around the edges or any signs of leaking.
- Granule Loss: Over time these granules loosen and fall off the shingles' base. Snow and ice in the winter can cause granule loss, so inspecting your roof is essential.
